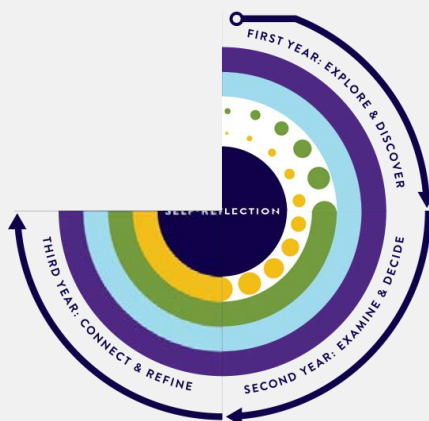
- Attend the Study Away Fair to explore upcoming Semester, May and Summer programs

FIRST YEAR



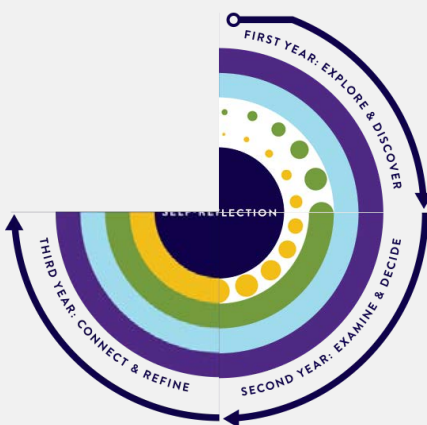
- Learn what “undergraduate research” means at Furman

SOPHOMORE YEAR



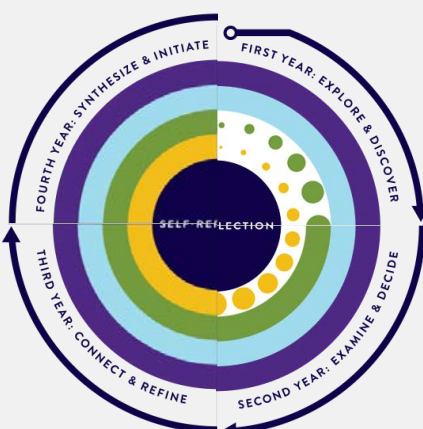
- Talk to your academic advisor, CEL Peer Ambassadors or staff in the Office of Undergraduate research about research opportunities

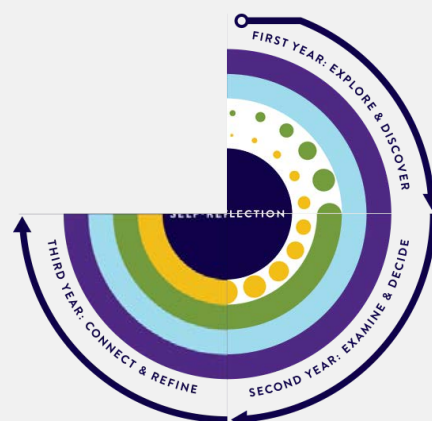
- Talk to your Academic Advisor about your interests, and meet with the Internship Office to learn about their services and find out about your strengths.
